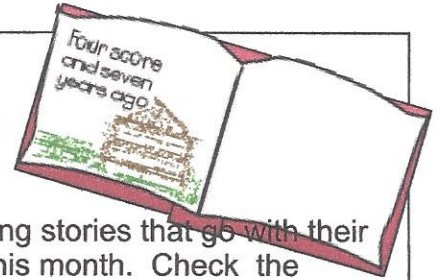

October themes include all things fall: foods of fall (including pumpkins), changing seasons and animals.

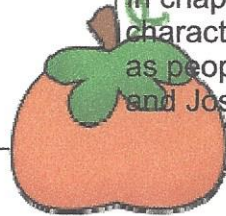
Classes are finishing up "God made animals" and are beginning a unit on "God made me."
